



# How to Apply For a Homestead Exemption

Tax Exemptions are determined by the status of the occupant on January 1st of each tax year. To apply for a Homestead Exemption, a homeowner must be occupying the property as his homestead on January 1st of the tax year in which the exemption is granted. You only need to apply once for the exemption. It remains on the property throughout your occupancy/ownership.

Your Appraisal District will automatically send a form to all new property owners around the end of January. You have until **April 30th** of that same year to file this exemption.
